## **Serve Others**

No one stumbles into discipleship or accidentally begins to follow Jesus better. God's Spirit directs us in the footsteps of Jesus every single day, and every step is a step of grace. In this series we'll look at three of our Next Steps that God wants us to keep taking.

These questions are designed to extend the impact of the weekend message. Use them to go deeper in your personal study time, with your family and/or with a group.

- 1 Have you ever worked in the service industry? Whether you were a waiter or a clerk, a janitor or a flight attendant, what did the job teach you about serving people?
- 2 Read John 13:1-5. Jesus shows us that love leads to service. Why is serving such a natural part of showing love? Share an example of someone in your life you have seen embody love that serves.
- 3 Read John 13:6-11. When Jesus says Peter won't have any part of him without being washed, Jesus isn't just talking about feet. Only Jesus can wash away sin. What does Jesus' saving work on the cross have to do with how we serve other people?

- 4 Read John 13:12 -17. Jesus served us so that we would serve others. Why do some chances to serve feel beneath us? In what way is Jesus calling you to follow in His footsteps and pick up the servant towel?
- **5** Jesus promises a blessing in the act of serving. Has this promise ever been true in your life? If so, share a blessing that God's brought to you through service.
