

## PALM TREE FORK PAINTING



### Supplies

- Paints in blue, turquoise, dark green, light green, brown, and white
- Paintbrushes
- Plastic forks
- Paint palette & water dish
- Canvas pad, canvas or white cardstock

### Directions

- Draw in the lines for the water and sand. You want the biggest part to be the sky, and to draw the sand line on an angle to add some interest.
- (Skip this step if you want just the tree). Paint the sky (blue), water (turquoise) and sand (brown and white mixed). Let that dry before moving on to the tree.
- Now it's time to draw in the palm tree. Using a pencil lightly draw in the trunk of the tree and some lines to indicate the leaves.
- Use a paint brush to paint the trunk (brown) and leaves (dark and light green).
- Finally use the fork to add texture to the trunk and leaves.

## M&M Rainbow Science Experiment



### Supplies

- Mini M&Ms
- White plate (ideally with a slope to the center)
- Warm water

### Directions

- Spread M&Ms out into a circle shape in the middle of the plate. You can experiment with trying different shapes, multiple layers of candy, and placing the candy in different locations on the plate.
- Carefully pour a thin layer of warm water under the M&Ms. Pour just enough water to cover the bottom of the plate.
- Watch as the colors spread across the plate!

## Bubble Snake Maker



### Supplies

- Bottle
- Scissors
- Elastic band
- Flannel, face cloth or an old sock
- Bubble mixture and water

### Directions

- Using a pair of scissors (and adult supervision), help your child by cutting the bottom off the plastic bottle.
- With your kids, cover the open end of your bottle with a piece of fabric that is similar to a washcloth or cotton sock. Secure with a rubber band to keep the fabric in place.
- Place your bubble mix into a shallow bowl or plate.
- Dip the fabric in the bubble solution and give the bottle a blow. Blowing slowly produces the longest snakes.
