



Jesus did not come so people far from God could find him. He came to find people who were far from God. There are many ways to get lost, but there is one way to be found—through the message and ministry of Jesus. And once Jesus finds you, he bids you to join him in his search and rescue mission.

Week 2: Find Your One... Who Was Wounded

1. Rick began by reminding us that *people get lost in different ways and for different reasons*. Why is that important for us to remember? Follow up: **Read Luke 15:8-10**. What's significant about how a coin might be lost? How is that relevant today?
2. **WELL SHARING. Read John 4:4-18**. What resonates with you the most from this story? Follow up: In what ways might she have felt inferior to Jesus? In what ways can you identify with the woman in this story and/or people who feel inferior too?
3. **Read John 4:19-26**. *The woman expected rejection but instead got an offer for redemption*. When have you felt God's concern and love for you?
4. **SHARING WELL: Every 1 is worth the search to Jesus**. *When it came to ascribing worth, Jesus did not use the worthless measures of his day*. How did Jesus demonstrate her worth? Follow up: How can we do the same with the people we encounter?
5. **SHARING WELL: Some 1 with wounds needs to be heard, not ignored**. *Jesus deliberately chooses not to argue or correct*. How do you think the woman felt when Jesus talked to her? Follow up: Who has God put in your life that you can listen to and care for as Jesus did with the Samaritan woman? How will you pursue this?
6. **SHARING WELL: No 1 can heal internal ills at external wells**. *Jesus knew that to help her he had to expose the futility of her well*. Why did Jesus steer the conversation in the direction of her woundedness? How can "living water" heal internal ills? Follow up: In what ways have you experienced for yourself the truth of **John 7:37-39**?
7. **SHARING WELL: Any 1 can find their true worth in Jesus**. *God gets the last word in your life...not your wounds*. How did this encounter help her find her true worth? Follow up: What is the most important thing you've learned from this message?
