## A New Birth 2.0 Experience

- 1. Why do you think our church places such a big emphasis on baptism? How does baptism connect us to Jesus' instructions in **Matthew 28:18-20**? Follow up: Share baptism stories.
- 2. **BAPTISM DECLARES... what Jesus did. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-4.** How can embracing the message of these Scriptures impact your faith journey? Follow up: Rick mentioned that baptism is an "*acted sermon*" declaring the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. How does this visual representation help us understand and remember the gospel message?
- 3. **BAPTISM DECLARES... what** *Jesus can do for me 2.0!* What does it mean for baptism to be the beginning of a life of "duplication" of *becoming like Jesus*? Follow up: How can understanding the significance of baptism help you live a different story (the story of Jesus)?
- 4. What power and promises are available to us through baptism, according to **Acts 2:38** and **Colossians 2:12**? Follow up: Why is it significant that the early church did not consider the notion of an unbaptized Christian?
- 5. **BAPTISM DEPICTS... the burial of you 1.0.** Baptism declares that we are letting go of who we used to be. **Read Romans 6:4.** How does baptism indicate our letting go of our old selves and trusting God to transform us? Follow up: Think about something you still need to "let go" of today. What practical steps can you take to surrender that to God?
- BAPTISM DEPICTS... the birth of you 2.0. In baptism we are not just asking God to bury the past; we are asking God to give us the power to live a new kind of future. Read Titus 3:5. What role does the Holy Spirit play in our new birth and ongoing transformation? Follow up: In what areas of your life do you need the Holy Spirit's guidance and empowerment as you Follow the Way of Jesus (to be with Jesus, become like Jesus, & do what Jesus did)?
- 7. Rick closed by asking this question: *Do you have a new birth 2.0 experience?* Why is it important to make our faith our own and go public for Jesus through baptism? Follow up: If you have not been baptized, what is holding you back? If you have been baptized, how has your life been different since making that public declaration of faith?
